Merlot and Cabernet Franc. Drink now through 2028." -B.S.

Rich and nicely layered in the glass, the 2011 shows the year's radiance and pure generosity in its open-knit personality and soft contours. Sweet red cherry, mocha, spice, mint and leather add shades of nuance on the close..." -A.G.
