<p>The 2007 Al Passo is 80% Sangiovese and 20% Merlot that flows effortlessly to a round, explosive finish layered with expressive dark fruit, flowers and spices. It shows marvelous density and richness in an opulent, full-bodied style. Floral notes reappear on the finish. Anticipated maturity: 2014-2022.</p>

<p>The 2007 Valdisanti is 75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Sangiovese and 5% Cabernet Franc that spent 16 months in French oak. It is the most complete of these 2007s, redolent with heady scents of dark fruit, licorice, leather and smoke. Balsamic notes develop in the glass, adding further layers of complexity and depth. This finishes with a joyful exuberance that is impossible not to admire. Anticipated maturity: 2014-2022.</p>

<p>The 2007 Picconero comes across as rather dark and powerful to the point of being excessively tannic for Merlot based wine in this vintage. There is tons of depth to the fruit, but I am not sure the tannins will ever fully soften in this huge, monolithic wine. Picconero is 65% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Petit Verdot. Anticipated maturity: 2015-2022</p>
